My work was to direct the office responsible for urban development of the undeveloped neighborhoods of Bogotá, which represent 25% of the city's territory, managing seven investment projects related to the integral improvement of the legal and physical conditions for housing and infrastructure of the neighborhoods and urban centers with the criteria of eco-urbanism, sustainable construction and social justice.

For this program the direct investment was 14 million dollars. I managed the execution and supervision of construction and consulting contracts, inter-administrative agreements, association agreements and service provision contracts. I was coordinating eight teams, comprised of 82 social, administrative and technical professionals. I promoted inter-institutional relations for execution of the projects and the formulation of Decree 476 of 2015 for the urban Legalization of Districts process.

I coordinated the process of urban regularization of neighborhoods lacking urban planning, as an instrument for recognition and normative incorporation of the conditions of these territories, guaranteeing the fulfillment of the goals of the project which were in low compliance. In addition, I promoted the institutional and organizational redesign of the process of urban regularization, by means of the formulation of the project of the Decree 063 of 2015 adopted by the Mayor of Bogotá.

Improving intergovernmental relations for public policy for the management of the Attention and Reparation to the Victims of the Armed Conflict was a central objective of the government. Therefore, I developed the following products: 1. Design of the categories and variables for monitoring public policy in the virtual platform: Unified Report of the Information System, Coordination and Territorial Follow-up of the Public Policy of Victims of the Internal Armed Conflict. 3. Support of the management of associated models for horizontal coordination among territorial entities, for the post-conflict period and the management of victim policy. 4. Design of instruments to strengthen the institutional capacity of territorial entities (regions, capital cities, municipalities and associative schemes). 5. Advice to the territorial entities about the design and implementation of the public policy for the victims of the armed conflict.


